- 1 The Government of Nepal in April 2003 received IDA Credit of an amount USD 3,769,788 and DFID Grant of an amount USD 6,342,780 towards the cost of the Financial Sector Technical Assistance Project (FSTAP).
- 2 The broad project components include: Re-engineering of Nepal Rastra Bank with a focus on strengthening regulatory and supervisory capacity, restructuring of two large commercial banks and supporting a better environment for financial sector reform in areas such as Credit Information Centre Ltd., Debt Recovery Tribunal, Secured Transaction Registry, financial journalism and training for staff in financial institutions.
- 3 The Nepal Rastra Bank (NRB), Banks and Financial Institution Regulation Department, Financial Sector Technical Assistance Project (FSTAP) now invites **Expression of Interest (EOI)** from qualified and eligible Nepalese individuals for the post of a Public Relation Officer (PRO) to work in Nepal Rastra Bank.
 - 3.1 The Public Relation Officer is expected to provide support and consulting services by assisting Nepal Rastra Bank (NRB) in developing the public relation strategy in a proactive manner to ensure that the general public is informed about the government's intentions with respect to financial sector reform and activities of financial sector reform as described in the Terms of Reference (TOR) available at Nepal Rastra Bank's website www.nrb.org.np.
 - 3.2 Interested Nepalese individuals having required qualifications, experience and adherence to the "Terms and Conditions" (available at NRB website) are requested to submit Expression of Interest (EOI) along with **Plan of Action**, curriculum-vitae and self-declaration documents.
 - 3.3 The Public Relation Officer will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's "Guidelines for Selection and Employment of consultants by the World Bank Borrowers, Revised October 2006". The copy can be availed from the Nepal Rastra Bank.
